

Chainsaw Pruning Guard Fitting Instructions



Small gap between chainsaw powerhead and guard 1cm but will vary from chain being new to chain stretching with use.

Note: Dimensions to chainsaw bar (not the chain).

- (i) Remove bar from your saw
- (ii) Measure 11cm on top of bar and approximately 14cm on bottom of bar as illustrated in the diagram above.
(Note: measurements are done with the chain removed)
- (iii) Mark the hole positions for bolting the guard to the bar. Centre punch the holes and drill out using a 8mm drill bit.
(Note: Make sure the holes are drilled equal distance from top to bottom of the bar. This will allow you to turn your bar from time to time for more even wear on your bar and provide for the correct positioning of the chain running through the guard).
- (iv) Position and tighten the 2 x bolts, spring washers and nuts supplied.

Note : For shorter bars, you will need to trim the Pruning Guard at the motor mount end to allow enough cutting length on the bar.
